TASK	HAZARDS	CONTROLS
1. Select appropriate stock to be manipulated.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Uneven, non-durable, or brittle stock may shatter and fling debris or entrap the user.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Hands on training and requiring shop instructor to provide guidance on the stock that is to be used by the student.</li> </ul>
2. Position material on table.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pinching of fingers and or hands.</li> <li>- Oscillating Blade.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Keep hands and fingers clear of blade when cutting material.</li> </ul>
3. Adjust Blade guard to proper height for material.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Damage to the equipment and or user if not set correctly.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Use hand guards.</li> </ul>
4. Set speed for material.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Body injury and or damage to work piece.</li> </ul>
